ACTIONS TODAY

- **November 4 is Voting Day.** If you have not already voted in Scarborough, we urge:
 - On **Scarborough referenda**, vote YES on Scarborough Questions 1 & 2, bonds for school construction.
 - On **statewide referenda**, vote NO on Question 1, to protect absentee voting, and YES on Question 2, to allow families to petition judges to take away guns from dangerous family members.
- **Food is being denied** to about 175,000 Mainers due to failure to continue funding of SNAP programs from existing emergency funds. Please consider donating – cash is best -- to food banks:
